



## Biography of Principals

### *Aelita Arampova* Chief Executive Officer

Prior to co-founding Anca Mrs. Arampova was Finance Director of Argo Capital Management Limited and senior investment analyst focusing on CIS and Eastern European investments. Besides being Argo's compliance officer Mrs. Arampova was in charge of investor relations as well.

Prior to joining Argo in 2002 Mrs. Arampova was a member of the institutional development team for the INOGATE (Interstate Oil and Gas Transport to Europe) Programme. INOGATE was sponsored by the European Commission studying hydrocarbon transportation from the Commonwealth of Independent States. It involved key decision makers (government ministers, leading businessmen) and resulted in an interstate umbrella agreement for hydrocarbon transportation signed by 22 countries of Eastern and Central Europe including Turkey and Greece. She was also member of the development team for Public Awareness campaign to prevent Abandonment of Children in Romania.

Prior to this, Mrs. Arampova was an editor and anchor woman of evening news programme on IBERIA TV channel and prior to that she served as TV reporter and radio journalist on Georgian State TV and radio Channel. Following her graduation from the university Aelita was retained by the Georgia State University of Georgia as a Greek language teacher until she left the country.

Mrs. Arampova has a BA with honours in philology (Russian and Greek literature and languages) from Georgia State University and a MA in history from Athens State University (Greece). Mrs. Arampova holds an Investment Management Certificate from the UK Society of Investment Professionals and is a CFA (Chartered Financial Analyst) charterholder. Aelita speaks 4 languages including English, Russian, Georgian, Greek and has conversational knowledge of Turkish.
