



## Biography of Principals

### *Nick Corby*

#### Chief Investment Officer

Nick Corby has over 20 years experience in trading Distressed Emerging Market debt and Special Situation Equity products. During this period Mr. Corby has worked as a proprietary trader or has been a portfolio manager. Prior to co-founding Anca Capital Partners with his partners, Mr. Corby was a director and fund manager at Argo Capital Management Limited, an investment adviser to three emerging markets funds. He joined Argo in 2004 to establish the Argo Global Special Situations Fund, which grew rapidly to have AUM of just under USD 400 million at the start of 2007.

Mr. Corby has previously worked as co-Director and Head of SE Asian Emerging Market Debt at Mizuho International, London. The business invested in a wide range of Asian and other emerging market debts with a product range from distressed corporate debt to performing sovereign debt. Mr. Corby joined Mizuho in 2000 from Kleinwort Benson Limited, part of the Dresdner Group. Mr. Corby was a Director and traded at Kleinwort's from 1995 to 2000 where he was responsible for trading illiquid debt.

Prior to joining Kleinwort's, Mr. Corby was a Director and shareholder of Henry Ansbacher Asset Trading ("HAAT") a company conceived by Mr. Corby and Mr. Riess. Capital for HAAT was injected by Henry Ansbacher & Co Ltd. The business was highly successful and was one of the first emerging market debt trading companies recognised for specialising in Emerging Market debt.

Mr. Corby started in the City as a graduate in Morgan Grenfell in 1981. Mr. Corby holds a Biochemistry degree from Leeds University and is a member of the Securities and Investment Institute.
